Rate Calculations

A. Call Duration

Business Customers

After the first 30 seconds of a call, the call duration is rounded up to the nearest 10th of a second except where otherwise specified.

Residential Customers

If the actual total duration of a call includes a fraction of a minute, the call duration is rounded up to the next whole minute, except where otherwise specified.

B. Applicable Rate Periods

The rate applicable is that rate which is in effect at the calling station when the minute begins. That is, if chargeable time begins during the Evening Rate Period, the Evening rate applies to any minutes occurring during that period. If the call continues into the Night Rate Period, Night rates apply to any additional minutes occurring during that period.

C. Total Charges

If the computed charges include a fraction of a cent, the fraction is rounded up or down to the nearest cent. On a split period call, each period is rounded separately and then added together.

Prepaid Calling Cards

A. General

Prepaid calling cards are used for the provision of MTS services for customers who prefer to prepay their long distance charges. The prepaid calling card is printed with an account and an $800 \, / \, 888$ access number for reaching the service platform. A Personal Identification Number (PIN) is also issued to the customer and is required to be entered at the time of access to the service platform to provide system and account security.

Customers who have received a prepaid calling card from ACS-LD dial the 800 / 888 access number and receive voice recorded prompts which guide them through the entry of their account number and PIN. Once these numbers have been successfully entered and validated by the service platform, the customer will hear a second dial tone, after which the telephone number he/she wishes to reach is dialed. The call is then completed by the service platform.

The account balance remaining on each account is also reported to the caller at the time he/she accesses the platform. The account balance is the amount of prepayment as determined by the customer at the time he/she purchased the card, less any toll charges since the time the original amount was purchased. For example, a customer may purchase a 60 minute calling card, with a perminute cost of \$0.30, or \$18.00 total cost. If ten minutes have been used by the customer since the original purchase, the remaining account balance is \$15.00. This amount is reported to the customer by a recorded voice.

Calls are billed in whole minute increments, with one minute being the initial period.
