## STEP 2 - SET YOUR EMERGENCY RESPONSE e911 LOCATION

You must set the emergency response e911 location for AKVoice lines before dialing outbound calls.



- 1. Log into the **ONEplace USER portal**.
- 2. Scroll to the bottom of the page to **Personal Details** section and click the **Set Emergency Location** link.
- 3. A new window will open to the my911 system.
- 4. As you type your address, select the correct address once it is displayed.
- 5. The location map will update with your address. Verify the red pin location is accurate, then continue scrolling down to verify the address details. Enter the name and comment you would like displayed to the 911 operator, in the event of an emergency.
- 6. Review the "Important Information" then select *Save*.
