



Short Term Public Notice Under Rule 51.333(a)

ACS of the Northland, LLC ACS of Alaska, LLC

Pursuant to Section 51.327(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 51.327(a), and Section 2.1.8, "Notification of Service-Affecting Activities," of both Intrastate Access Services Tariff RCA No. 359 (ACS of the Northland, LLC ("ACS-N")) and Intrastate Access Services Tariff RCA No. 251 (ACS of Alaska, LLC ("ACS-A")), ACS-N and ACS-A provide the following information concerning the retirement and removal of certain legacy local switches within their respective service areas:

Implementation Date: On or after November 15, 2026. ACS-N and ACS-A are therefore providing short-term Public Notice of these changes pursuant to Section 51.333 of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 51.333.

Location of the Planned Network Changes:

ACS-N and ACS-A, respectively, intend to decommission and retire their legacy local switches in the Nenana central office (the "Nenana DMS-10") and the Eielson Air Force base central office (the "Eielson DMS-10") as follows:

Description of the Planned Changes:

As indicated above, on or after the specified implementation date, ACS-N will decommission the Nenana DMS-10 and ACS-A will decommission the Eielson DMS-10, and remove those legacy

switches from their respective networks. All traffic (including without limitation all local, extended area service (“EAS”), wireless, paging, intrastate access, and interstate access traffic) currently served by those switches will be migrated to the Metaswitch in the Fairbanks, AK central office of ACS of Fairbanks, LLC (“ACS-F”), located at 645 5th Ave. Fairbanks, AK 99701, CLLI Code FRBNAKXADS2 (the “Fairbanks Metaswitch”).

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

To accommodate increased traffic to the Fairbanks Metaswitch, competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless service providers, paging carriers, and other affected service providers may need to augment existing trunk groups, secure new trunk groups, or otherwise modify their interconnection arrangements in the ACS-F central office in Fairbanks identified above. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Nenana DMS-10 or Eielson AFB DMS-10 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Fairbanks Metaswitch. These carriers may also choose to discontinue trunk groups or other current interconnection arrangements to the Eielson AFB DMS-10 or Nenana DMS-10. Interconnection arrangements and exchange of traffic at other points in the ACS-N and ACS-A networks are not expected to be affected by this change.

All Access Service Requests (“ASRs”) for the Fairbanks Metaswitch switch must be received no later than October 1, 2026, in order to ensure sufficient time to implement those ASRs and migrate the affected traffic, as described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration from the Nenana DMS-10 or Eielson AFB DMS-10 switch prior to their eventual decommissioning and removal. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Nenana DMS-10 and Eielson AFB DMS-10 switches. This will serve to guide interconnection re-routes of traffic for the native codes currently served by those switches to reflect the Fairbanks Metaswitch as the new home switch.

As required under Section 51.333(a) of the FCC’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 51.333(a), ACS-N and ACS-A are serving this notice upon each telephone exchange service provider that directly interconnect with their networks, at the address provided for receipt of notices under its interconnection agreement or other interconnection arrangement, at least five business days prior to the start of the short-term public notice period. In addition, ACS-N and ACS-A are disclosing the contents of this Notice to each interexchange carrier or other service provider interconnected with their networks. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 64.702(d)(2).
